

# **Prosser Community Volunteers**

# The "Leadership Team" was selected from the list of volunteers and the Leadership Team will be responsible to:

- 1. Recruit individuals to serve on the Prosser Community Volunteers.
- 2. Screen and select proposed organizations, individuals, and projects pursuant to the adopted selection criteria.
- 3. Routinely review and if necessary, update the organization, individual, and project selection criteria.

# **Draft Project Selection Criteria will include evaluation of the following:**

The Organizational Recipient The Individual Recipient

The Project Description

#### **Selected Organizational Recipients must be:**

- 1. in the coverage area of Jubilee Ministry.
- 2. a non-profit and not a tax supported organization or entity.
- 3. absent the necessary employee labor force to accomplish task.
- 4. approved at the discretion of the Prosser Community Volunteers Leadership Team.

### Selected Individual Recipients must be:

- 1. in the coverage area of Jubilee Ministry.
- 2. able to demonstrate the need for assistance.
- 3. without other options for assistance such as family/friends, church, or other organizations.
- 4. living in a permanent residence at a registered address.
- 5. willing to accept and attend counseling sessions if made a condition of accepting service.
- 6. willing to accept a schedule for assistance which has a termination date.

#### **Project Selection will be:**

- 1. prioritized based on need.
- 2. prioritized based on the overall value to the individual or benefit to the community.
- 3. contingent upon the ability and expertise of the volunteer base to accomplish the project.
- 4. absent funding or capital-raising efforts for an individual or organization.
- 5. in line with the "values statement" for Jubilee Ministry.

#### Initial list of services to be offered by the Prosser Community Volunteers through Jubilee Ministry

- 1. delivering Jubilee Food Bank products to shut-ins.
- 2. delivering Prosser Farmers Market produce to shut-in customers.
- 3. providing assistance for selected community events.
- 4. community gleaning project to gather potatoes, onions, and other available products for use in the Jubilee Ministry food bank.

## Future list of services to be considered by the Prosser Community Volunteers:

- 1. Providing labor to distribute Farmers Market/Prosser Community Volunteers brochure to Prosser households.
- 2. Providing rides for medical services to shut-ins.
- 3. Providing physical assistance for house or yard maintenance to handicapped or infirmed.
